

Supportive Macro Trends for Consumption Growth

India's economic and market outlook currently provides a promising environment for investors. The macro landscape is steadily improving—with inflation moderating to 3.34%, global crude oil prices comfortably remaining below \$70, and the RBI implementing a series of measured rate cuts to support growth. In light of the economic slowdown, the government has shifted its focus to boosting domestic consumption through modest tax cuts and supportive fiscal measures. These developments set a favorable stage for consumer sectors, making both discretionary and non-discretionary consumer-facing companies potential beneficiaries.

At the heart of this outlook is a clear rationale. Lower inflation translates directly into increased real disposable incomes, thereby strengthening consumer confidence and driving higher spending. The RBI's recent rate cuts have eased borrowing conditions, which not only encourages a modest rise in loan demand but also contributes to improved net interest margins for consumer financing businesses. In particular, NBFCs that specialize in consumer financing are well positioned to benefit from both heightened consumer activity and improved margins due to lower funding costs. Additionally, stable energy prices—evidenced by crude oil consistently trading below \$70—help maintain predictable operating costs for both businesses and households. Moreover, the government's prudent approach to stimulating domestic demand amid ongoing slowdown challenges is expected to foster a steady cycle of enhanced consumer expenditure.

In summary, the convergence of an improving macro environment, a supportive policy stance, and rising domestic demand creates a compelling case for investment. Based on these factors, we have identified select stocks in consumer-facing sectors and NBFCs that are well-positioned to benefit from these tailwinds.
